
Aerosky — Baggage Policy

What You Can Bring

- Every ticketed passenger on Aerosky flights may bring one (1) “personal + carry-on” set free of charge:
 - A personal item (like a purse, small bag, laptop bag, or briefcase)
 - A carry-on / bag that is small and compact enough to meet safety and space constraints for our aircraft
- All baggage — carry-ons, checked bags, or special items — must meet Aerosky’s safety, size and weight requirements, and are subject to inspection. If baggage appears unsafe, oversized, or otherwise unsuitable for carriage, Aerosky reserves the right to refuse transport.

Checked & Additional Baggage

- If you need more than the free carry-on allowance, you may check additional bags — subject to available space — at fees set at booking.
- Any extra or oversized bags may incur additional or “excess baggage” charges.
- Because we operate small-to-mid sized aircraft, weight and size limits for baggage will apply; oversized or overweight items may be denied or require special arrangements.

What Care to Take: Fragile, Valuable, or Oversize Items

- For safety reasons, Aerosky cannot guarantee safe carriage of fragile, perishable, or high-value items (e.g. artwork, jewelry, electronics, antiques, delicate instruments) in checked baggage.
- If you must transport such items, please contact us in advance — we may require special packaging or may ask that they travel as carry-on (if permissible) or under special terms.
- Aerosky is not responsible for damage to fragile or perishable items, or for “normal wear and tear” (minor scratches, scuffs, dents, weather effects, etc.).

Special or Oversized Items

- Oversized items (e.g. sporting equipment, large containers, musical instruments, bulky gear) may only be accepted on a case-by-case basis, and only if space and safety allow.
 - You should contact Aerosky in advance to declare these items.
 - Acceptance of special items is never guaranteed, and additional fees may apply.

Baggage Fees & Payment Terms

- Standard carry-on / personal item: Free
 - Additional checked or excess baggage: Fee applies (shown at time of booking)
 - Fees depend on bag size, weight, and number of pieces — and are subject to change based on aircraft, route, and availability
 - Overweight/oversize items may incur surcharges or be denied

Mobility Devices, Strollers, Service Items, Infant Gear

The following are typically accepted free of charge, subject to safety, space, and regulatory rules:

- Mobility aids (wheelchairs, crutches, canes, walkers)
- Strollers, car seats, infant/child-safety seats
- Medical devices (portable oxygen, approved assistive devices)
- Diaper bags or other essential child-care items

Please notify us in advance if you will travel with any such items so we can accommodate and allocate appropriate space.

What If Your Itinerary Connects with Other Airlines

If you combine your Aerosky flight with other airlines under a single ticket, baggage policies and fees will depend on the first carrier in the itinerary.

If your trip involves separate tickets, baggage will not be automatically transferred — you will need to claim and re-check baggage between flights.

Important Reminders

- Baggage policies may vary by aircraft type, route, and operational conditions.
 - Aerosky reserves the right to refuse carriage of any baggage that does not comply with size, weight, safety, or regulatory requirements.
 - Always label your baggage clearly and travel with valuables, documents, and fragile items in your carry-on when possible.
 - For any unusual baggage (oversized items, sports gear, instruments, delicate items) — contact us ahead of time for approval.

Aerosky — Baggage Policy & Fees

Baggage Allowance & Guidelines

Item	Allowed / Limit	Notes
Carry-on + Personal Item	1 carry-on bag (small/compact) + 1 personal item (purse, laptop bag, briefcase, etc.) per ticketed passenger	Bag must fit within size/weight limits and be suitable for our aircraft's storage constraints. All carry-ons may be subject to planeside stowage if needed.
Standard Checked Bag (free allowance)	Up to 50 lb (≈ 23 kg) and up to 62 linear inches (length + width + height)	Fits within aircraft baggage compartment or cargo area. Subject to space and safe loading.
Additional/Second Checked Bag	Same limits as standard bag (≤ 50 lb & ≤ 62 linear inches)	Accepted only if space allows. Additional fees apply.
Overweight / Heavy Bag	Bags between 51–70 lb (23–32 kg), same size limit (≤ 62 in)	May be accepted, subject to space; additional “heavy-bag” surcharge applies.
Oversize / Bulky / Special Items	Items that exceed size or weight limits (e.g. oversized gear, large containers, bulky items)	Acceptance is conditional, by prior approval only; may be refused or charged extra.

Important: Because Aerosky uses small aircraft (e.g. Cessna 208 Caravan), baggage space is limited. All carry-ons, checked bags, and special items are subject to safety, loading, operational, and space availability.

Why These Limits?

- The typical baggage compartment / cargo capacity for a Cessna 208 Caravan is limited. The aircraft's baggage/cargo area supports a modest total cargo volume and weight capacity. ([Cessna](#))
- Overweight or oversized bags may interfere with safe loading, weight & balance, or emergency egress — so they may be refused or require special handling.

Baggage Fees

Bag Type / Situation	Fee (per bag, per segment/flight)
Standard Carry-on / Personal Item	Free
Standard Checked Bag (≤ 50 lb / ≤ 62 in)	Free (as included in fare)
Additional Checked Bag (2nd bag, standard)	\$30
Overweight Bag (51–70 lb)	\$80 surcharge (on top of any standard/extra-bag charge)
Additional Bags beyond 2nd (if allowed)	\$100 each additional bag
Oversize / Bulky / Special Items	Price on request — must be pre-approved

Bags heavier than 70 lb or larger than 62 linear inches will not be accepted.

These fees may vary depending on aircraft used, route, and operational conditions. Final baggage fees will be confirmed at booking/checkout.

Note: Because we operate small aircraft, excess baggage and overweight/oversize items are never guaranteed — they are always subject to space availability and may be denied even if fees are paid.

What to Keep in Mind & Customer Tips

- Label your bags clearly. Include name, contact info, and flight date — for easier handling and identification.
- Pack valuables, fragile items, and essentials in your carry-on / personal item. Aerosky's liability for fragile or high-value items in checked baggage is limited.
- If traveling with bulky or special items (e.g. sports gear, oversized luggage, instruments) — contact us ahead of time. You may need special handling or extra fees, and acceptance is not guaranteed.
- Travel light when possible. Given limited space, we appreciate efficient packing.
- Arrive early. Baggage must be checked and secured before departure, and space is assigned on a first-come, first-loaded basis.

Standard Baggage Policy Disclaimer

- All baggage acceptance is subject to space, loading capability, aircraft configuration, and safety regulations.
- Aerosky reserves the right to refuse any baggage that exceeds size or weight limits, appears unsafe, or cannot be loaded safely for any reason.

- Fees, allowances, and policies may change depending on aircraft, route, and operational conditions. Always check at time of booking.
 - For bulky, fragile, or valuable items — carriage is at customer's risk. Aerosky's liability for damage or loss is limited per our Contract of Carriage.
